Lead Lifeguard – Full-time Seasonal

The Hamlet of Tulita is seeking to hire one (1) Lead Lifeguard for the Recreation Department. The Lead Lifeguard reports directly to the Director of Recreation and is responsible for supervising, operating and leading programming at the Tulita community swimming pool throughout the summer months.

The ideal candidate must meet the below qualifications and enjoy creating a positive and safe environment for all community members. Applicants for this position must be 18 years of age or older and have availability to work a flexible schedule including evenings and weekends.

This is a full-time seasonal position working 40 hours per work.

The Lead Lifeguard is required to have the following certifications:

- Valid First Aid and CPR Certificate
- National Lifeguard Standard Instructor/Examiner Certificate
- Examiner Bronze Cross Level
- Pool Operators 1 Certificate (Preferred but not required)

Duties Include:

- To provide an environment that has the overall safety of the public and staff as the prime consideration.
- Oversee and manage the Assistant lifeguard and junior staff;
- To provide enjoyable aquatic opportunities and programs to the public;
- Shall maintain records of Pool conditions, equipment, and facility.
- To maintain Chlorine levels of the pool water and maintain the Sand filters;
- In liaison with the Director of Recreation creates the pool programming schedule (i.e. swim lessons, lifesaving lessons, public, family and teen swims);
- The Lead Lifeguard will be expected to lifeguard swims and teach programs for the season with help from the assistant lifeguard.
- Ensures that the facility complies with the Lifesaving Society Pool standards; and
- Completes all other related duties as required.

This position pays between \$30.00 - \$35.00 an hour dependent on experience. Relocation flights to and from Tulita for the summer will be covered, and accommodations are available.
