Duties & Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Plans and manages municipal infrastructure projects from initiation to completion, ensuring scope, budget, and timelines are met.
- Coordinates with internal teams, external consultants, contractors, and stakeholders to deliver projects effectively.
- Oversees technical aspects, including reviewing designs, tender documents, and conducting inspections for quality assurance.
- Manages project budgets and financial reporting, including cost estimates, forecasts, and payment approvals.
- Ensures regulatory compliance and safety standards, while maintaining clear communication and reporting to senior management and council.

Education and Experience:
